<u>Form</u> if your child is vaccinated. This form is designed to help Carver HSES Staff capture and confirm the vaccination status of Carver HSES students in order to help support timely communications and

COVID-19 investigations. There is no penalty if your child is NOT vaccinated and/or if you choose NOT to complete this form.
